

Double-counting of GE Capstone Courses

As endorsed by the General Education Office, students in the English Major may apply to have the following GE Capstone (GCAP) courses offered by ENG “double-counted”. This means that ENG Major students taking a GCAP course on offer may apply to have the successfully completed GCAP course counted toward their Major/Major elective requirements, even as cumulative units will NOT be doubled as a result. Hence students taking GCAP courses are required to take any one ENG Major elective course as a replacement course toward fulfillment of the graduation requirement of 128 total units.

For example, students taking GCAP 3056 (Taking a Stand: Engaging in Public Discourse through Advanced Research and Writing) can “double-count” this course with ENGL2027 or a different Major elective course found on the course list below.

Starting AY 2020-2021, ENG will offer two GE Capstone (GCAP) courses:

- GCAP 3056/Taking a Stand: Engaging in Public Discourse through Advanced Research and Writing (co-taught with the Language Centre)
- GCAP 3057/Interdisciplinary Independent Study in Social Action
